

# WINE LIST

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## WHITE WINE

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### Tierra Alta Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

175ml **4.35** / 250ml **6.35** / Bottle **19.00**

*Grown in the foothills of the Andes using no chemicals or fertilizers and pure meltwater for irrigation, this combines the fruity style of Marlborough with the restrained mineral side of Sauvignon from the Loire Valley. It's a real find and easy on the palate.*

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### Caliterra Reserva Chardonnay, Chile

175ml **4.85** / 250ml **7.00** / Bottle **21.00**

*Brilliant, light greenish-yellow in colour. Pronounced notes of citrus fruit and minerals stand out on the nose, accompanied by interesting notes of chilli pepper and tomato leaves. Intensely aromatic on the palate with bright acidity that makes this a fresh wine that is pleasing to drink.*

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### Gregoris Pinot Grigio, Italy

175ml **5.30** / 250ml **7.65** / Bottle **23.00**

*'Antonio Fattori really knows how to handle his white grapes — originally a Soave producer, he planted Pinot Grigio long before it became fashionable and continues to produce probably the best example even now. Fresh, ripe white stone fruits on the palate, a hint of sherbet, with a lightly honeyed touch on the finish. Whatever next? Pinot Grigio with true character.'*

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### Bosman Chenin Blanc, South Africa

175ml **5.75** / 250ml **8.30** / Bottle **25.00**

*This is the wine the Bosman family enjoys with a weeknight supper or a relaxed Saturday braai (barbecue). It is accessible and compatible with an array of dishes and occasions without compromising on quality.*

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### Ontanon Vetiver Rioja Blanco, Spain

Bottle **28.00**

*Produced solely from 100% Viura grapes grown in the Siete Caminos vineyard and indigenous to Rioja, on south-east facing slopes. This wine is aged according to the typical white Rioja method: 4 months in American oak, followed by 6 months in the bottle prior to release.*

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### L'Omarine Picpoul de Pinet, France

Bottle **31.50**

*Picpoul de Pinet is a tiny appellation in the commune of Herault, in the very South of France. Cave de l'Ormarine's vineyards lie at approximately 40 metres above sea level, overlooking Lake Thau. Dry, refreshing white with plenty of crisp apple and white peach flavour. Great with shellfish.*

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### Raza Vinho Verde, Portugal

Bottle **29.00**

*One of our favourites — outstanding levels of freshness and fruit with a hint of petillant character giving the wine great lift and vibrancy. Green apple, grapefruit, melon, and cucumber. Think sunny days!*

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### Chablis Fournillon, France

Bottle **38.00**

*Transport yourself to the Kimmeridgean soils of Chablis for this complex wine. Fermentation is first carried out in stainless steel vats, then the wine is aged for 12 months before bottling and release. Perfect with freshly caught fish.*

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## ROSÉ

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### Mirabello Pinot Grigio Rosé, Italy

175ml **4.60** / 250ml **7.00** / Bottle **19.00**

*A dry, fresh and fruity rosé with delicate aromas of red berries. Crisp and lively on the palate with good intensity of ripe berry and red cherry fruit. Made from Pinot Grigio with just enough Pinot Nero to give it that wonderful blush. So easy to drink.*

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### Château L'Ermitage Rosé Auzan, France

Bottle **20.00**

*A pretty, aromatic nose. Cranberry flavours on the palate with just a hint of tannin underpinning the bright acidity. Elegant and well-balanced, this is a great food rosé with a modern and stylish finish.*

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### Château d'Esclans Whispering Angel, France

Bottle **38.00**

*'Have you ever known an angel to shout? This is a real Icon of Provence. Very clear and clean and will gain flavours during the year'*

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### Rimauresq Rimauresq Cuvée Rebelle 2018, France

Bottle **41.50**

*Plots selected to make Rebelle are some of the oldest on the Domaine de Rimauresq estate, planted on schist over forty years ago. Due to the north-west aspect and shade from the intense sun given by the Massif des Maures mountains Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault ripen slowly before being harvested in the cooler hours of the morning. For Rebelle, Pierre Duffort opted for the slower rosé de saignée (bleeding) method, with fermentation by naturally occurring yeasts only. Full-bodied style.*

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## RED WINE

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### Tierra Alta Cabernet Sauvignon, Chile

175ml **4.35** / 250ml **6.35** / Bottle **19.00**

*A soft, friendly-style wine from Chile, a world class producer of typical Cabernet Sauvignon. Full of blackcurrant and cedar-like aromas; flavours so typical of its variety. Reminds you a lot of chewy blackjack sweets with light tannins. This wine has a round, weighty palate.*

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### False Bay Pinotage, South Africa

175ml **4.85** / 250ml **7.00** / Bottle **21.00**

*Seen as South Africa's signature grape variety, Pinotage is a crossing breed from Pinot Noir and Cinsault grape varieties. Made from 30-year-old, unirrigated bush vines which gives intense concentration of flavour. The False Bay Winery have produced a superb example of Pinotage, which is deep garnet in colour. On the nose there are hints of dark fruits, chocolate and eucalyptus leading to a heady mix of fruit, rich chocolate and plums supported by soft tannins.*

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### Vista Alianca Terra Boa, Portugal

175ml **5.00** / 250ml **7.40** / Bottle **22.00**

*A blend of Tinto Roriz (Tempranillo), Touriga Nacional and a small part of Cabernet Sauvignon. The wine is a fresh and modern take on Portuguese reds, moving away from the dark and brooding characteristics. This is a warm and softly spiced red — all juice and character. Fermentation and aging of the fruit is carried out in stainless steel vats, and every winemaking decision is about retaining bright, approachable, blackcurrant, raspberry, and dark cherry flavours.*

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### Caliterra Merlot Reserva, Chile

175ml **5.75** / 250ml **8.30** / Bottle **25.00**

*This wine is an attractive, bright and lively ruby-red. It is fresh on the nose, with notes of fruits such as plum and strawberry, accompanied by mild aromas of coffee beans and mocha.*

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### Molinillo Malbec, Argentina

Bottle **28.00**

*This wine has a bright, lifted nose with freshly picked black berry fruits and expressive violet notes. The palate is juicy, but balanced. Ripe berry fruits are abundant, whilst gentle spice adds dimension. Weighty, with soft, gentle tannins, and an enduring fruit-charged finish. Malbec for purists.*

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### Vega del Rayo Rioja Reserva 2013, Spain

Bottle **30.00**

*Full-bodied and flavoursome Rioja Reserva. The wine is crimson in colour with a slight orange tinge towards the rim. The nose displays aromas of dark forest fruits, violets, coffee and spice. The palate has plenty of body with fine, slightly grippy tannins and plenty of fruit evident. The finish is of good length with a savoury twist to it. Classic!*

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### Bardos Ribera Del Duero Reserva Romantica 2016, Spain

Bottle **35.00**

*After 14 months in new and used wood, the fruit is deep and smoky. Bright tannins and polished aromas of figs and herbs. Licorice, five spice and bittersweet cherries make up the long finish. 100% Tinta del Pais from old, low-yield vineyards in Quintanilla de Onésimo. A deep, dark and brooding one for red meat dishes.*

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### Boutinot Rhône Seguret 2017, France

Bottle **38.00**

*An impressive, classic Séguret — about as good as Côtes du Rhône-Villages gets! Paler ruby than some earlier vintages due to the extreme proportion of Grenache, the nose is as explosive, plush and opulent as ever, layered with exotic spice, cracked black pepper and streaked with vanilla. The palate is instantly appealing, polished and smooth on entry, but steeped in depth and texture as the flavours swirl around, lengthen and delight.*

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## SPARKLING WINE

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### Dolci Coline Prosecco Spumante, Italy

200ml **6.50** / Bottle **25.00**

*Fresh and gently fruity fizz from the north-east region of Veneto with citrus and green apple aromas. Delicate and lively on the palate with ripe, lightly grapey fruit, zesty acidity and a clean, refreshing finish.*

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### Dolci Coline Prosecco Spumante Rosé, Italy

Bottle **25.00**

*Clean and fresh rosé — light and zesty, easy-drinking with or without food*

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### Gremillet Brut Champagne NV, France

Bottle **50.00**

*Lively, fruity Champagne. Pale yellow colour, the nose displays elegant lemon and acacia notes, supported by berry fruit nuances. The palate is full and powerful with elegant fruit and refreshing acidity.*

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### Gremillet Rose Champagne NV, France

Bottle **58.00**

*This champagne is an attractive pink colour, with ripe strawberry and vanilla rolling over your tongue. This is enhanced by classic baked biscuit flavours and crisp yeastiness. Champagne Gremillet are a small, but beautifully formed family-owned champagne house, situated in the far south of the Champagne district near the town of Les Riceys. Gremillet age all their champagnes for a minimum of 24 months to ensure that the wines are not too young, and all the elements have married.*

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### Ruinart R Champagne Brut NV, France

Bottle **75.00**

*A vibrant, clear yellow colour with golden reflections. Good brilliance with sustained effervescence and a very persistent foam. Unambiguous on the palate. A balanced wine, rounded and full-bodied, scented with ripe nectarines and greengages. The finish is long; the well-integrated dosage giving way to the characteristic freshness of the Chardonnay which makes up most of the blend. A perfect champagne for aperitifs whatever the occasion.*

*The blend is made up of 40% Chardonnay, 49% Pinot Noir and 11% Meunier, 20 to 25% of which are wines reserved from the two previous years.*

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### Ruinart Blanc de Blancs Champagne Brut NV, France

Bottle **85.00**

*A blend of 100% premier cru Chardonnay from different years, this non-vintage features a profuse mousse that provokes a supple and harmonious palate. This is a well-balanced, rich, suave and soft wine, with subtle honey and mineral flavours and a long, sustained finish.*

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
